

Implementation of Budget Proposal - Textile and Apparel Industry

The budget proposal 2012 announced that;

- a) Export oriented apparel manufacturers who are exporting the minimum of 75% of their production will be permitted to sell the balance in the local market on the payment of all inclusive tax of Rs. 25/- per a piece and Rs. 25/- for a bundle of six pieces of panties, briefs, socks and boxer shorts.
- b) Export oriented textile millers will be permitted to sell 25% of their production in the domestic market on the payment of Rs. 40/- per kilogram. You are kindly requested to implement this proposal immediately enabling to meet the market demands during this festive season.

You are hereby informed the above proposals are implemented with immediate effect. Please take required action for smooth implementation of this decision.

Please also note that the general policy thus, the individual companies are not required to obtain the approval of the BOI for this purpose. Therefore, BOI and Custom must ensure unnecessary procedural complexities are not introduced.
