Procurement of Supply and Installation of Oracle Exadata Systems and Related Software Licenses for Sri Lanka Customs

- 1. The Chairman of High Level Procurement Committee on behalf of the Director-General of Sri Lanka Customs invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for the Procurement of Supply and Installation of Oracle Exadata Systems and Related Software Licenses for Sri Lanka Customs. The implementation period for supply and installation is sixty (60) days and Support and Maintenance period eight (8) years.
- 2. Bidding will be conducted through the National Competitive Bidding (NCB- Single Stage Two Envelope Bidding) procedures specified in the National Procurement Guidelines, and are opened to all eligible bidders as defined in the Guidelines.

Bidders must meet the following minimum qualification criteria for the contract award:

- a) Manufacture Authorization: The bidder must be an authorized Oracle partner in Sri Lanka.
- **b) General Experience**; Bidder should have general experience in Information Technology Contracts in the role of contractor during at least last **Five (5) years** prior to the bid submission deadline:
- c) Specific Experience: Bidder should have successfully completed at least one (1) Oracle Exadata Systems Implementation including database migration with the same technology as Oracle Database Management System with a value at least LKR 300 million within the last three (3) years.
- d) Average Annual Turnover: Bidder should have minimum average annual turnover of LKR 300 million calculated as total certified payments received for contracts in progress or completed, within the last three (3) years.

100,000/-) to the Chief Shroff, 2nd floor, Sri Lanka Customs on working days, from 9.00 am to 3.00 pm on or before **06.06.2025**. The method of payment will be cash only.

- 5. Bids must be delivered to Logistics Directorate, 6th floor, Sri Lanka Customs, No. 40, Main Street, Colombo 11, **before 3.00 p.m.** on **06.06.2025.** Late bids will be rejected. Bids will be opened soon after the bid closing in the presence of the bidders' representatives, who choose to attend at **3.00 p.m.** on **06.06.2025.** All bids must be accompanied by a Bid Security in the form of bank guarantee of not less than **Sri Lankan Rupees Twenty Three Million (LKR 23,000,000.00)**.
